UPDATE - Please Read: HEALEY ATTENDEES DRIVING OR TRAILERING THEIR STREET HEALEY TO ROAD AMERICA FOR THE HEALEY WORLD CHALLENGE EVENT

- 1. The Discounted Entry Fee for Healeys applies only to Healeys and Other Display Sportscars. No motorhomes, trucks or rigs with trailers are allowed inside the **Upper Paddock Areas**, due to potential congestion and conflicts with racer parking areas in the Upper Paddock. Additional vehicle parking information will be available at the Registration Building, and they will answer your questions.
- 2. Everyone who has prepaid for the Healey World Challenge must **first go the Registration Building to get your credentials**. There is a parking lot at the Registration Building for cars. Trucks etc. with trailers can turn right upon arrival and drive past the Registration Building to turn around in the field and park there until credentials are issued. The **Paddock Pass** and wristband you receive will **only allow your display sports car** to enter through the tunnel and proceed to the preferred parking area in the Upper Paddock. Motorhomes, trucks and other tow rigs with trailers, and other non-display vehicles, will be allowed to enter the track with wristband, but will not be allowed to enter through the tunnel to the Upper Paddock. Instead, they will be directed left or right before the tunnel to inside track parking areas accessible by the shoulder roads for off-loading and parking your tow vehicle or passenger car.
- 3. If you desire Overnight Paddocking, inquire at Registration. There is no charge for overnight Paddocking, however, if ELECTRICAL hook up is desired, you will need to contact Road America and purchase a Camping Permit for Camping from Road America, which does includes electrical.
- 4. For Healeys and Display Cars, once you have received your **wristband and Paddock Pass**, and you may take your Healey and your Healey passengers (or your street car with passengers) through the security checkpoint, and through the tunnel to the Upper Paddock. There will be VSCDA people available with golf carts to escort you to the <u>Preferred Healey Paddock Parking Area</u> that is reserved **ONLY** for Healeys and other Display Sportscars.
- 5. If you need to return to your vehicle, truck and trailer, there will be Road America shuttles running throughout the day. Once your Healey is on display, please keep it in the display area throughout the day.
- 6. Anyone who wishes to leave their Healey in the display area overnight may do so, but please remember to secure your car. Road America does have security roaming around, but here is no posted guard for this area.
